

Please register for the lunch at the club so that we can arrange the catering. Registration for the bridge component may be done online as usual.



### Director's Corner



Here are few reminders and clarifications of common situations at the bridge table:

- **HESITATION** during bidding: is not an infraction, but the player's partner must not be influenced by the hesitation.
  - ALL responses to **Stayman** should be alerted.
- **Dummy** can attempt to stop Declarer committing an infraction, but cannot draw attention to it once it has occurred. For example, if **Declarer** plays from the wrong hand by either calling for a card from Dummy, or playing incorrectly from their own hand, **Dummy must not** draw attention to this, as the infraction has occurred.

- Dummy **should not move cards** to fill a space created by a suit void, as this is disruptive to Declarer and Defenders.
- When a **claim** is **made by Declarer**, they must state their proposed line of play. This should make mention of any outstanding trumps (eg. "drawing trumps"), and how they plan to travel between hands if relevant.
- Recording Results: When you are on opening lead, your first priority after the auction is to make the opening lead. This should be done before entering the contract into the Bridgemate. The same applies to dummy spread your hand before doing anything else.
  - Alerts: Do not explain the meaning of an alerted bid unless asked by an opponent.
